Enclosed are the Material Safety Data Sheets for the wood dust, urea-formaldehyde and phenol-formaldehyde that may exist on products distributed by The Penrod Company. The Occupational Safety and Health Administration regulations require that we distribute this information sheet along with a wood dust label to our customers.

The Penrod Company is in receipt of Wood Dust, Urea Formaldehyde and Phenol-Formaldehyde MSDS Sheets from our various suppliers. This MSDS summarizes the health and safety information concerning wood dust, urea-formaldehyde and phenol-formaldehyde and it is believed to be reliable.

ATTENTION CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS: Proposition 65 Warning

The state of California (OEEHA Prop 65) has classified wood dust as a chemical known to cause cancer in humans. Wood dust can also cause a flammable or explosive hazard. Drilling, sawing, sanding, and machining wood products can produce wood dust. Avoid inhaling wood dust or use a dust mask or other safeguards for personal protection. California Health & Safety Code Section 25249.6

- Avoid dust contact with an ignition source
- Recover dust for disposal
- Avoid prolonged breathing of wood dust and contact with the eyes and skin
